

Grand Opening: The Bonnier Gallery Inc. to Debut Pre-Art Basel in Miami's Burgeoning Art District and Highlight Minimalist & Conceptual Movement

-- Space for Those Who Value Intersection of Literature and Visual Art --

MIAMI – Oct. 1, 2018 – The Bonnier Gallery Inc. — Miami's newest minimalist and conceptual fine art gallery—is set to open its doors on Thursday, Nov. 29, featuring new works by Richard Höglund and Kathleen Jacobs, just one week prior to Art Basel 2018. The newly constructed space, located in Miami's Allapattah neighborhood adjacent to the internationally-renowned art districts of Design District and Wynwood, will be a haven for art lovers.

Gallery owner Grant Bonnier, along with his wife and business partner Christina Bonnier, are Miami natives who felt compelled to create a space that will shine among their neighbors in Miami's unique art enclave. Their concept for the gallery is inspired by early 20th century artists for whom form and philosophy melded in artistic expression.

"Throughout history, the artist and poet have worked in tandem," said Grant Bonnier, whose plans for The Bonnier Gallery include working with community art purveyors like Books & Books and O, Miami. "The celebration was one of ideas, with less emphasis on form. Our goal is to create a space for those who value this intersection of literature and visual art."

In addition to emphasizing the connection between poet and artist, The Bonnier Gallery seeks to connect with their native South Florida.

"It is important to us to be a year-round location and really cement ourselves with the Miami community," Christina Bonnier added. "This will take form in everything from offering stipends for interns from local universities to providing a venue for local fine arts students through summer shows, poetry readings, lectures, and more."

The Bonnier Gallery will place an emphasis on exceeding the expectations of even the most discerning collectors in the area. Via curating works from renowned artists that include Sol Le-witt, Robert Mangold, Donald Judd, Agnes Martin, Christo, Robert Ryman, and Carl Andre, the Bonniers seek to broaden a market otherwise often limited to New York galleries.
